The Opening Ceremony for World Masters Games (WMG2017) will be held at Eden Park on Friday 21 April 2017. It is a private event for the participants of the games and their supporters to attend and is not open to the general public. Summarised below is the event operations plan for the public spaces outside of Eden Park. The operational plans, detailed below, reflect the resource consent and have been developed by Eden Park with input from other operational stakeholders including NZ Police, Auckland Transport and Auckland Council. Information on operations within the stadium should be sought from Eden Park.

**Major Event Management Act:** WMG2017 has Major Event Status under the Major Event Management Act. For Eden Park the clean zone covers the entire Stadium as well as the surrounding environs please refer to site map in Appendix 1.

**Crowd estimate:** Planning for this event reflects estimated attendance of 30,000, and all agencies are aware of this. Information on Eden Park Stadium operations can be found at [www.edenpark.co.nz](http://www.edenpark.co.nz)

**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT**

A number of traffic management provisions will be put in place with the approval of Auckland Transport and will be managed by Evolution Road Services.

**Resident access:** Residents will be advised of the accredited vehicle and resident access points via the Eden Park letter drop being delivered on Thursday 13 April. Access points are as follows:

- Residents east of the venue access via either Dominion Road / Walters Road or via Burnley Terrace / Marlborough Street
- Residents on Sandringham Road south of the venue approach from the southern end of Sandringham Road
- Residents west of the venue access, via Taylors Road into Morningside Drive.

**Residents parking:** The residents parking scheme will be activated for this event. Residents are required to display valid parking permits when parking on the street. Residents can obtain a permit by contacting Auckland Transport on (09) 355 3553. For more information about the Residents Parking Scheme please see the Auckland Transport website [www.at.govt.nz](http://www.at.govt.nz).

**Parking restrictions:** Various parking restrictions will be implemented around the Eden Park precinct, Bond St, New North Road, Dominion Road, Gribblehirst Park, Takapuna, Western Springs and in the CBD to assist with event operations (public transport, mobility parking, taxis and traffic flow). Legal signage will be erected by Evolution Road Services. Parking restrictions will be in place from 4pm-11pm.

**Mobility parking:** This will be located on Cricket Avenue (between Walters Road and Reimers Avenue). Accreditation for mobility parking includes national or international mobility passes or a WMG2017 pass see below in Appendix 2.

**Mobility Shuttle:** Auckland Transport will be running a mobility shuttle between Eden Park and Morningside train station. Pick up is outside Papa's Pizza on the corner of Sandringham Road and Rossmay Terrace.

**Taxi stands:** Taxi drop off pre event on the Cricket Avenue loop, post taxi pick up from 8.00pm on west side of Dominion Road north and south of Walters Road.

**Public Transport:** An integrated ticketing system has been implemented for this event. Travel on the following services to Eden Park on rail up to 3 hours and bus services approximately 3 hours prior to the ceremony starting until end of service is included with the event accreditation. A split rail system between Kingsland rail station and Morningside station will be implemented from 8.00pm. Attendees will show WMG2017 accreditation to board special event services.

- Manukau/Botany/Pakuranga
- Newmarket/Mount Eden
- Northern Busway (to Albany Park & Ride)
- Auckland City Centre Buses (Quay Street between Britomart Place and Tangihua Street 4.00pm-11pm)

### **Event Parking.**

Motions Road: Permission has been provided for the WMG2017 performers to park in the car park outside TAPAC on Motions Road on 20-21 April between 4pm-11pm. Taxis and shuttle buses will be used to transport to Eden Park and return.

### **EVENT OPERATIONS**

**Waste management plan:** Waste management in the external environs will be provided by Total Property Services.

- Bins will be in place outside of the stadium (within the area defined as Zone A)
- Eden Park will provide liquor disposal bins at each of the liquor ban check points (see liquor ban section below)

**Portaloos:** Four portaloos, provided by Kennards Hire, will be placed at each of the following locations prior to gates open:

- Wairepo Swamp Walk – Eden Park are aware that portaloos are not to be placed on the artwork
- Kowhai School gates on Kowhai Street
- Reimers Avenue near the bus hub
- Outside the Mobil petrol station on Sandringham Road

Two portaloos will be placed in the following locations

- Adjacent to gate E (corner of Reimers and Cricket)
- On Cricket Ave outside the stadium (opposite Raleigh Street)

The existing Council toilets on Bellwood Avenue near Dominion Road will operate as per normal.

**Liquor ban:** The Major Event Liquor Ban will be in force in the streets surrounding Eden Park. For information on the ban and included streets please see:

**Structures:** There will be no additional structures in the external environs other than, portaloos and rubbish bins as listed above. No building consents are required.

**Amplified sound:** Operations within the stadium will be in accordance with the conditions of resource consent. Eden Park will be monitoring noise in the stadium as per their resource consent. Activations at the entrances of Gate A, D, E and H will be the responsibility of ATEED and will be in accordance with the conditions of the Eden Park resource consent.

**External activations:** ATEED is producing pre-opening activations between 5.30pm-7.20pm. These activations will include live music, stilt walkers and face painting and will be located on Eden Park grounds at the entrance plazas (gates A, H, E and D). Operation plans to be worked through with Eden Park. There are no activations planned for the external Eden Park environs. The production office for ATEED activations will be at Kowhai School. All activation equipment will be cleared manually to the base site.

**Security:** Eden Park will provide a security presence outside of the stadium to the satisfaction of Auckland Council and NZ Police. Security services will be provided by Platform4 Group.

**Consultation:**

- Eden Park will send their standard letter to residents and local businesses, prior to the opening, including event day operations, traffic management measures and resident and business access points.
- Permanent street signs advising of the residents parking scheme will be uncovered by Auckland Transport prior to the event
- Event advisory signage will be put up by Evolution Road Services Ltd on behalf of Eden Park in the week leading up to each event at key locations within the vicinity of the precinct.
- A Notice to the Local Board has been sent.
